Horse. Entries open to equines 4 years old and over. No stallions allowed. A negative Coggins test and rabies certificate required within 6 months.

General Information:

- Dressage test will take place in an indoor arena. Warm-up will be outside with a few minutes scheduled inside the indoor arena.

- The judge will be available to explain comments after the morning and afternoon rides.
- A third test may be permitted on the day of the show if time permits. Class fees apply.
- Only Delaney Stables horses are allowed in the barn. All other competitors enter through the designated arena door.
- Proper dress required. Does not have to include a show coat and may include half chaps instead of tall boots.
- **It is compulsory that all riders mounted at any time, anywhere on the grounds wear properly fitted protective headgear** which meets or exceeds current applicable ASTM/SEI (American Society for Testing and Materials/Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag "Protective Headgear," with chin strap secured. **Any rider without protective headgear will immediately be prohibited from further participation in the event** until such headgear is properly in place and/or at management's sole discretion may be prohibited from participating further in the DS Club event.
- A TREC Demonstration will take place at 12:15. The obstacle course will then be open to competitors to explore as well as an unmounted orienteering route.
